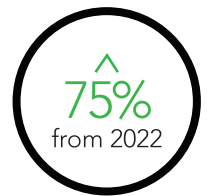

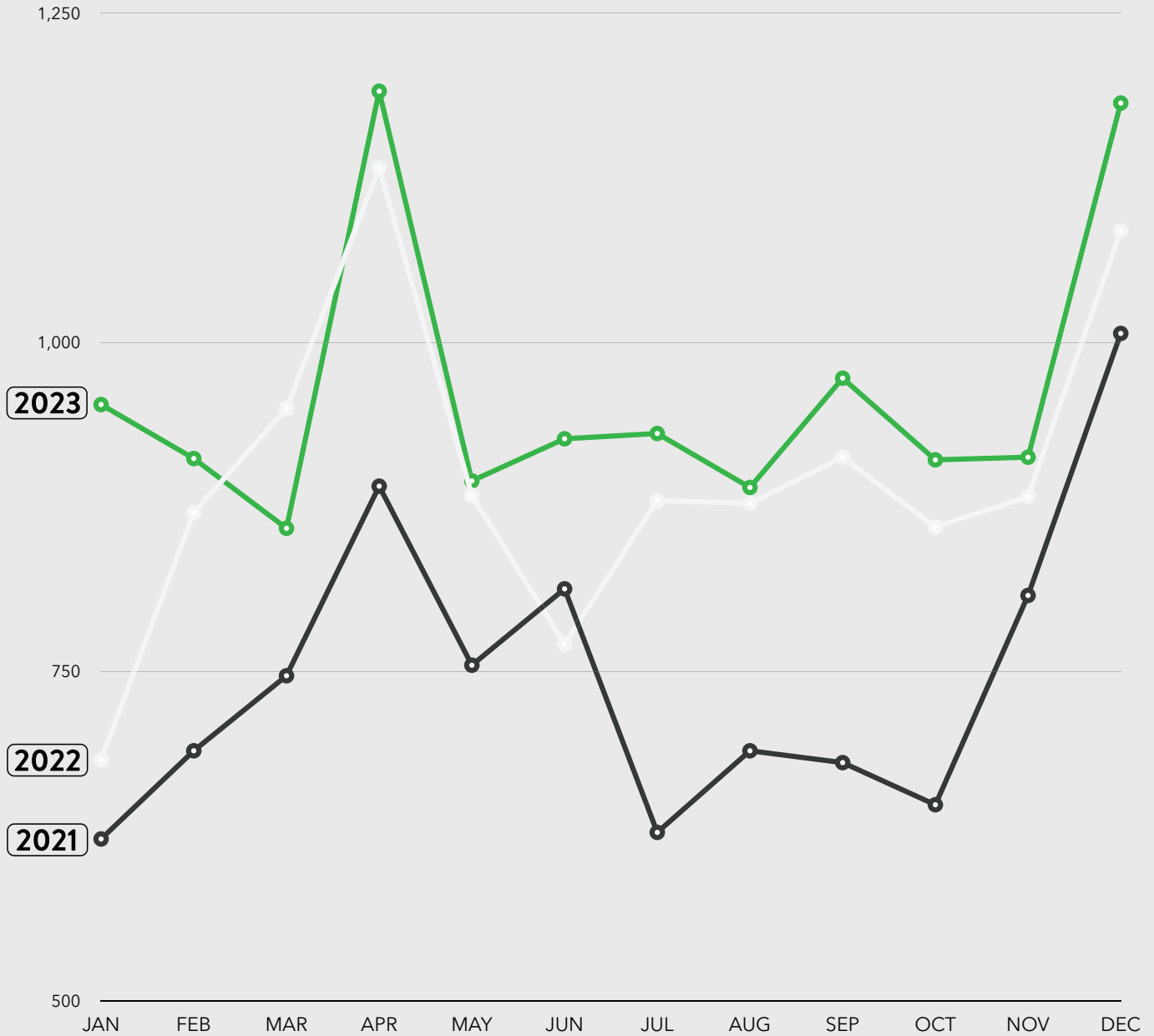

FOUR WAYS NEW LIFE REACHED OUR COMMUNITY IN 2023:

CAR CARE

We celebrated Mother's Day by caring for 40+ single moms and their cars. While the moms were pampered with manicures and massages, volunteers outside changed oil, checked tire pressure, and detailed cars.

CASINO ROAD KIDS

New Life supports CRK financially every month to aid in their after school programs. CRK gives kids a safe, fun environment to study, make friends, and learn about Jesus.

RUNTOWIN

In our second year of partnership, RunToWin hosted 33 camps that taught kids about Jesus through the lens of sports. In 2023, over 80 kids gave their lives to Jesus at a RunToWin Camp.

MADISON AVENUE THEATER

Every Friday night, New Life opens its *Madison Avenue Theater* for a free, family-friendly movie. In 2023, over 9,000 people attended a movie.



REACHING THE WORLD

Global Outreach



Through your generosity expressed in giving toward global missions, New Life Church has been able to support missionaries, ministries, and churches all around the world.

The global partners we supported include the following:

- **Compassion First:** Rescuing women from human trafficking in Indonesia.
- **Homes of Hope:** Cody and Lindsay Spang. Last year over 500 homes were built in eight different nations (including Ukraine) for displaced families.
- **Imani Collective** (Jenny Nuccio): Providing ethical wages and Christian community for disadvantaged and unreached women in Mombasa and Turkana, Kenya.
- **Foursquare Missions:** Foursquare missions is doing work in over 150 nations and has over 100,000 churches. We give monthly support to their overall mission efforts. Furthermore, we give additional support to some of their missionaries and projects, including the following:
 - **Steve and Kim Cecil** (MENACA)
 - **Jeff Roper** (Europe and MENACA)
 - **Brenda Kean** (Jacaranda - Kenya)
 - And more

Additionally, New Life Church gave a tithe of \$202,876 from our general fund to support Foursquare Church multiplication both in the U.S. and around the world.

We also gave special offerings to visiting missionaries throughout the year, partnering with African Hospitality Institute (Uganda), ThinkSmall (children's evangelism - reaching over 1,000,000 children with the Gospel last year!), Brandon and Marcie Brazee (Germany), and others.

Our ability to support these missionaries is dependent on your designated offerings, beyond your regular giving to New Life Church. In 2023, \$134,734.81 was given to our Go! missions fund. Thank you for partnering with what God is doing around the globe!

THREE WAYS NEW LIFE HAD A GLOBAL REACH IN 2023:

IMANI COLLECTIVE

For over ten years, Imani Collective has empowered artisans through dignified work, opportunity, and community. Imani began in Mombasa, Kenya, and has since expanded to multiple regions in the country. New Life has partnered with Imani to open a new weaving center in Turkana, Kenya.

MATTAW CHILDREN'S VILLAGE

In Kigali, Kenya, displaced children are able to find restoration, education, care, and a family at Mattaw through an unconventional orphanage model of homes with a mom and dad that care for 10-14 kids at a time. New Life supports Mattaw monthly to aid in ongoing operations.

JACARANDA

Led by Foursquare Missionary Brenda Kean, Jacaranda is serving the needs of their community in Nairobi, Kenya by providing jobs, education, healthcare, and a church community. New Life has partnered with Jacaranda to build a new faith-based community center in Kibira, one of the largest slums in Africa.

Kids Trek



At Kids Trek, we commit to share Biblical truths of God's character, the message of Jesus, and the Gospel. Kids learn who they are because of who GOD is. We rejoiced with 29 elementary students who made decisions to follow Jesus as their Savior. Now that's something worth celebrating!

We create a culture where kids feel a sense of belonging through relationships. We believe every kid needs to feel included and connected.

We foster a fun atmosphere! Using high-quality media and games, kids have a blast at Kids Trek.

We teach kids how worship is a lifestyle and a response to God's goodness. Each week a team of 12 elementary students led worship in Kid's Church. It's powerful to see this generation step into leading worship at a young age.

We equip our kids to walk in the power of the Holy Spirit as a follower of Jesus. We believe He is just as alive and available to them as He is to us.

We believe in dedicating children to the Lord. We host classes where parents hear the biblical reasons for dedicating a child back to the Lord. In 2023, we dedicated 25 children.

Young moms gathered weekly for Coffee Connect and discipleship through the Bible Recap study.

Throughout the year, pre-teen students were water baptized. We provide classes for kids and parents to ensure they have a clear understanding of baptism. Last year we celebrated 20 student baptisms, most of whom were baptized by their parents.

Youth Interns were given practical opportunities to teach and lead worship during Kids Trek classes. Raising up this generation to lead is a high value.

Now, we are preparing our hearts and anticipating that God will do exceedingly, abundantly above all that we ask or can imagine in 2024.

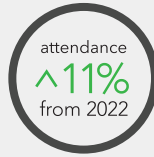

In 2023, we introduced new access points that provide dual opportunities for students. These opportunities enable them to have fun and invite their friends, creating space for evangelism, while still fostering connections with God, their leaders, and each other. These opportunities include SNAC (Sunday Night After Church), Sunday Morning Breakfast Club, and leader-to-student small groups within our ALIVE Nights on Wednesdays.

Throughout the year, we witnessed not only steady growth in attendance but also a stronger presence of students serving within the walls of New Life and our surrounding community.

This fall, we introduced and reintroduced new opportunities. We revived Invite Night, scheduled for 5th Wednesdays throughout the school year, encouraging students to bring their friends. During Invite Nights, we deliver a gospel message while fostering a fun atmosphere. Another addition to ALIVE is Survive, where we host a Survive Challenge during gatherings. Students are divided into Tribes and engage in friendly competition for a prize at the end of the Survive season, culminating at our Invite Nights.

Looking ahead to 2024, I am prayerfully considering ways to integrate the essence of Life Groups into our weekly gatherings to deepen our discipleship to Jesus and strengthen our faith.



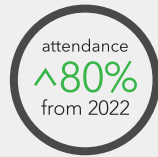

Internship

In October 2023, we kicked off The Internship at New Life! The focus of the Internship is to equip, educate, and send out servant-hearted, spirit-filled, and holistically healthy leaders to reach the world through the church and the marketplace.

This year's interns have had the opportunity to serve in a variety of ministries at New Life, grow in leadership skills, and work on developing a life statement that describes who God has created them to be.

There are two opportunities for young people to be a part of The Internship - a Fall to Spring program that runs from September to May, as well as a Summer Program for college students needing practical ministry experience that runs from June to August.

We are excited to see how Jesus continues to bring young people to the church to be a part of The Internship. God is doing something special in this generation and we believe we are going to see more and more young leaders being sent out to proclaim the good news of Jesus.

Leadership Training

In the summer of 2023, Leadership Training was launched at New Life. Jesus said, "Whoever wants to be a leader...must be your servant." - Matthew 20:26. In other words, those who serve are the leaders in God's kingdom and at New Life Church. The New Testament teaches three radical truths about the nature of the Church:

- It is not a holy place ... it is a holy people
- It is not inanimate ... it is alive
- It is not complete ... it is still under construction

We want to make sure we are not just consuming information, rather we are working toward transformation. Jesus said we are to not only hear, but we are also to obey...to live it out. As we take the things we learn from Him and apply them we become more like Him and we become all He has called us to be as His Church.

Spiritual Leadership is defined as "an authentic human being, who genuinely seeks to live their life by Jesus' example, filled by the Spirit, and leading in alignment with God's will, purpose, and plan."

At New Life we have created a collaborative learning environment that occurs three times a year through books, resources, and discussion. Over 300 leaders in 2023 were being trained for transformational impact.

Men's Ministry

The men's ministry has shown continued growth in fellowship, community, and strength this past year. Men with a desire to lead and love their families well are devoting themselves to personal growth and their walk with Jesus. These are men who are willing to stand in the gap and fight the battle together.

We currently have five Life Groups dedicated to men of all ages, with an average of 75-80 men each week gathering to share life and follow Jesus together. We anticipate a couple more groups to start this spring.

We have quarterly events like breakfast, outings, and BBQs where guys can have fun competition, hear a message, and recharge each other with wisdom, laughter, and truth. Most events bring in 80-85 men with the last one having 107 men hearing about being an "Impact Player" for the kingdom.

Last summer we had 67 men devote the weekend to attend the first retreat we have had in twelve years – guys who want to be better fathers, better sons, better husbands, and better men. Men who put aside the business of life to recharge and be refreshed in Spirit, mind, and body.

Facility

We are blessed with a 92,000 square foot building to call home. Our facility underwent a number of needed updates in 2023 in order to continue serving our church for many years to come; including a new roof, chairs and a sound system for the Worship Center, restriping our parking lots, and more. 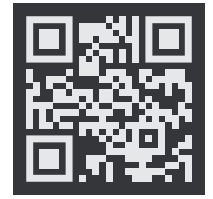

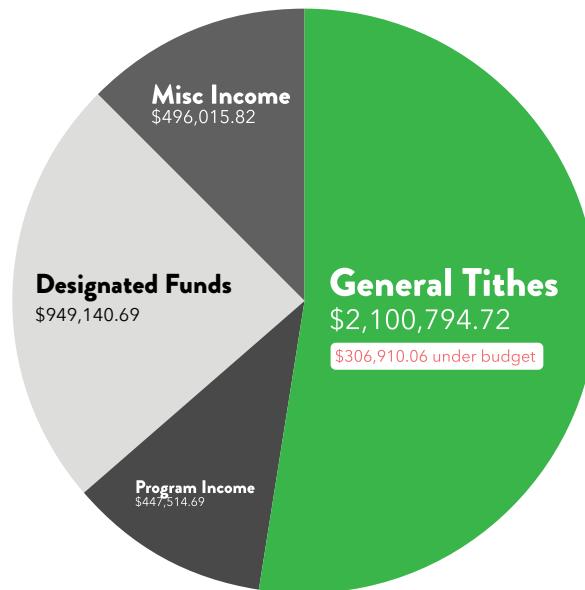
